First, let's recap Sunday's message together.

Q1: What is the central theme of Psalm 120?
Q2: What is repentance? What does it mean to repent?
GREEK AS OUR GUEST
The greek word "Metanoia" (μετάνοια) means a "complete change of mind, a new direction of will, and an altered purpose in life." This is where our word "Repentance" comes from. ———————————————————————————————————
Pastor Daniel emphasized three choices/actions we must make to experience true change or repentance. Let's take a look at all three.
Q3: REJECT: What does it mean to reject the world's false advertisement? How do we do this?
Q4: RECOGNIZE: What kind of lies have we believed that led us away from God?
Q5: RESOLVE: We must resolve that Jesus is telling the truth. What can we do to grow in our resolve that Jesus is the only Way, the only Truth, and the only Life?

Q6: What happens when we reject repentance? What happens when we surrender to it?
