RECAPPING FROM SUNDAY'S MESSAGE

Message: What is truth?

Scripture: John 18:37-39

Series: The King in Question

Q: At the beginning of his sermon, Pastor Daniel emphasized that we share a common dilemma with Pilate - finding absolute truth. In John 18:38, Pilate asked Jesus, "What is truth?" Sadly, he did not pursue the answer to his question. However, let us answer this question now. What is truth?

JOHN 14:6

In John 14:6, Jesus makes a bold and exclusive claim about Himself:

"Jesus said to him, 'I am the way, and the truth, and the life. No one comes to the Father except through me.'"

Q: How can we be so confident that Jesus is the truth - the only way?

Q: In his book, *Renovation of the Heart*, Dallas Willard emphasizes our need to be transformed from the ways the world has formed us to the ways and truth of Jesus. So, please share about a moment, or the first moment, when you felt the inward tug to make the final decision about Jesus.

Q: What type(s) of transformation have you experienced since you decided to follow Jesus?

Q: How can we be people of the truth - followers of Jesus?

Q: How can we begin to bring hope and truth to those around us who are seeking a way through this crisis?
